

Job Description: Research Intern

Accountability Initiative, Centre for Policy Research is seeking to hire two interns for a period of three months from last week of October, 2018 to last week of January, 2019 on an education related project. The position is Delhi based.

About Accountability Initiative

Accountability Initiative (AI) was set up in 2008 at the Centre for Policy Research (CPR) with a mission to deepen research, analysis, and reforms for strengthening accountability for public service delivery in India. We do this by:

- a. Building Evidence: Tracking and analysing implementation processes (planning, budgeting, decision making) of social sector programmes including education, health, sanitation and nutrition; and evaluating accountability experiments
- b. Deepening Public Debate: Widely disseminating evidence collected to promote an evidence based debate on accountability failures and solutions
- c. Catalysing Accountability Interventions: Building citizen capacity to participate and monitor government processes; and partnering with government to pilot reform models

Background to the study

Al seeks to hire interns for an ongoing mixed methods study on government reforms in education and teacher practices in Delhi. The study is part of Al's research in understanding bureaucracy and embedding systemic reforms. The positions require the interns to travel to selected sites within Delhi and do desk work at the CPR office.

About this position

The interns would be required to undertake the following tasks under the supervision of the research associates attached to the studies-

- i. Conduct primary data collection in the form of structured classroom observations.
- ii. Do data cleaning and primary analysis, and prepare brief reports on findings emerging from the field.
- iii. Assist in project management and any other associated task assigned by the supervisors.

Qualifications

- i. Bachelor's degree in Education, Development Studies, Social work, Economics, Public Policy or any other Social Science discipline. (Essential)
- ii. Strong analysis, writing and presentation skills. (Essential)
- iii. Experience in conducting surveys, field data collection, and analysis. (Highly Desirable)
- iv. Proficiency in data analysis using MS Excel. (Essential)
- v. Familiarity with data analysis tools such as STATA for quantitative and NVivo for qualitative data analysis (Desirable)
